Called Council Meeting
Monday, April 18, 2011
Council Chambers

The Mayor and City Council for the City of Loganville met on Monday, April 18, 2011 for a special Called Council Meeting for the purpose of discussing FYE 6-30-2012 Budget and Sunday Alcohol Sales. Mayor Ray Nunley and Council Members Dan Curry, Wendell Geiger, Mark Kiddoo, Michelle Lynch, Rey Martinez and Jerry Price were all present. City Manager Bill Jones, City Attorney Karen Woodward, Police Chief Mike McHugh, Human Resources Director Kristi Ash, Finance Director John Cheek, Police Captain Gregg Warnack and Fire Marshall Kent Durden were also present.

Mayor Ray Nunley called the meeting to order at 11:30am.


Council Member Mark Kiddoo presented the FYE 6-30-2012 Budget to the Mayor and Council and read the appropriations ordinance. Council Member Mark Kiddoo made a motion to approve the FYE 6-30-2012 as presented. Council Member Wendell Geiger seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.


City Attorney Karen Woodward presented the Mayor and Council with the resolution calling for a referendum to authorize Sunday sales by the drink for consumption on the premises at licensed locations. Council Member Rey Martinez made a motion to adopt the legislation drafted by the City Attorney calling for a referendum on Sunday sales by the drink on the premises in any eating establishment within the corporate limits of Loganville which is licensed to sell alcoholic beverages for consumption on the premises and which derives at least 50 percent of its total annual gross income from the sale of prepared meals or food. Council Member Dan Curry seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-1 with Council Member Jerry Price voting in opposition.

City Attorney Karen Woodward presented the Mayor and Council with the resolution calling for a referendum to authorize Sunday package sales of malt beverages and wine on Sundays at licensed retail locations. Council Member Michelle Lynch made a motion to call for a referendum to be placed on the November 2011 ballot for Sunday package sales of malt beverages and wine as passed during the 2011 Legislative Session of the Georgia General Assembly pending the enactment of the bill into law. Council Member Wendell Geiger seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0 with Council Member Jerry Price voting in opposition.

With no further business to discuss, Council Member Dan Curry made a motion to adjourn. Council Member Wendell Geiger seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.
