

RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION FOR THE CITY OF LOGANVILLE, GEORGIA PROVIDING FOR THE ADOPTION OF THE REVISED GEORGIA STATE MINIMUM STANDARD CODES FOR CONSTRUCTION; TO PROVIDE FOR THE NOTICE OF REVISION; TO PROVIDE FOR THE ADMINISTRATION AND ENFORCEMENT OF SAID STANDARD CODES; TO PROVIDE FOR THE SAFETY AND WELFARE OF THE PUBLIC; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Whereas, the Uniform Codes Act became effective in Georgia on October 1, 1991; and

Whereas, on July 1, 2004 the Act was revised to make the following codes with Georgia Amendments mandatory as the Georgia State Minimum Standards Codes, listed editions effective January 1, 2008:

International Building Code	2006 Edition
International Fuel Gas Code	2006 Edition
International Mechanical Code	2006 Edition
International Plumbing Code	2006 Edition
National Electric Code	2005 Edition
International Fire Code	2006 Edition
International Energy Conservation Code	2006 Edition
International Residential Code	2006 Edition (excl. plumbing and electrical);

Whereas, the City of Loganville desires to adopt the following optional codes as provided for by the Act:

International Property Maintenance Code	2003 Edition
International Existing Building Code	2003 Edition; and

Whereas, the City of Loganville has previously adopted administrative and enforcement procedures and penalties to locally enforce the mandatory and optional codes.

Now, therefore, by this resolution, the City of Loganville shall enforce the above listed editions of the mandatory codes and hereby adopts the above listed editions of the optional codes in compliance to and in the continual enforcement of the Rules and Regulations of the Georgia State Minimum Constructions Standards, to be effective 1 January, 2008.

In witness thereof, the Mayor and City Council of the City of Loganville hereto have caused this document to be in effect this 13th day of December, 2007.
