## CURBSIDE COLLECTION PROGRAM



### WHAT

The City of Loganville Curbside Collection Program provides you with an easy and efficient method to store your household waste and reduce your waste generation through recycling. Each resident receives a Roll Cart for non-recyclable solid waste and a new eighteen (18) gallon Recycling Bin that will allow you to easily recycle. Our contractor, **Waste Pro**, is contracted to empty the contents of the Roll Cart and any additional bagged waste each week. If you regularly have more than fits in one cart, please call City Hall for a second one. No tires, used oil, furniture, paint or chemicals, yard waste or white goods are to be placed for collection. Both should be placed curbside by 7:00 AM on designated collection days.

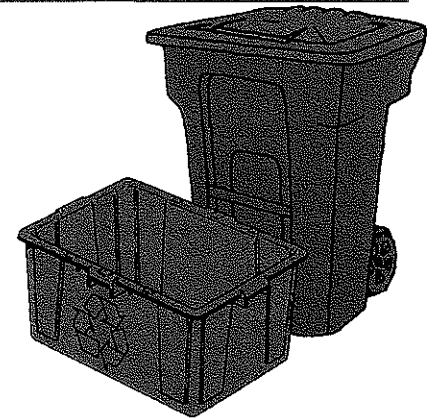
### WHEN

The City of Loganville Curbside Collection Program includes weekly curbside Recycling and Roll Out Cart service began on **October 2 2006**. Both services are provided on the same day. Waste Pro will be providing services to Loganville Homes on three different days each week. Please contact City Hall for service day information for your home.

### How Do I RECYCLE

It's so easy to recycle! Just follow these three simple steps:

1. Collect your glass containers (green, brown and clear), aluminum beer and soft drink cans, clear plastic soft drink bottles, clear plastic milk and water jugs and place them in your Recycling Bin. Place your newspapers at the bottom of the Recycling Bin.
  2. Place your Recycling Bin at the curbside by 7:00 AM on your **assigned day** for collection. The materials will be picked up, sorted at the curbside, processed locally and readied for shipment to recycling markets.
  3. Repeat steps 1 and 2 each week to help conserve limited landfill space, energy and natural resources.
